<p><b>INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER</b></p> <p>To vote, fill in the oval (●) next to the candidate/response of your choice.</p> <p>To vote a "Write-in", fill in the oval next to the blank write-in line and write the name of your choice on the blank write-in line.</p> <p>If you make a mistake, request a new ballot from an election worker.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>COUNTY QUESTION</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OFFICIAL BALLOT GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ELECTION</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>BANNOCK COUNTY STATE OF IDAHO November 7, 2017</b></p> <p>QUESTION: Shall Bannock County, Idaho (the "County"), issue and sell its negotiable bonds in the amount of up to \$16,000,000 for the purpose of providing for (i) the acquisition, construction and equipping of an addition and related remodeling and improvements to the existing Bannock County jail facilities, and (ii) the acquisition, construction and equipping of a facility for the provision of crisis care, stabilization and alternatives to incarceration, including behavioral, substance abuse, and mental health services, and to pay expenses related thereto and costs of issuance of the bonds, said bonds due in such installments as fixed by the County Commissioners of Bannock County, Idaho, the last installment due and payable not more than twenty (20) years from the date of the bonds, as more fully provided in Bond Election Ordinance No. 2017-8 adopted by the County Commissioners of Bannock County, Idaho, on September 18, 2017?</p> <p>The project to be financed by the sale of the proposed bonds is set forth in the above QUESTION. The date of the bond election is November 7, 2017. The principal of the bonds to be issued is up to \$16,000,000.00. The anticipated interest rate on the proposed bonds, based upon current market rates, is two and ninety-eight hundredths percent (2.98%) per annum.</p> <p>The total amount to be repaid not later than twenty (20) years from the date of such bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate, is \$21,668,225.00, consisting of \$16,000,000.00 in principal and \$5,668,225.00 of interest. As of November 7, 2017, the total existing bonded indebtedness of the County, including interest accrued, is \$0.00.</p>
