



## INFORMATION REGARDING THE BOND PROPOSAL FOR BANNOCK COUNTY JAIL FACILITY ADDITION AND BEHAVIORAL CARE CENTER

*A community-driven continuum of care addressing behavioral health needs and public safety*

### THE ISSUE

The number of people in our community with behavioral and substance use issues has reached crisis levels, resulting in severe overcrowding of Bannock County Jail and a lack of meaningful treatment for those in need.

### THE PROPOSAL

The proposed Behavioral Care Center of Bannock County would provide crisis care, stabilization and alternatives to incarceration and hospitalization.

- 1 CRISIS CARE CENTER | Up to 24-hour crisis care provided 365 days per year**
  - Immediate, short-term care for individuals in crisis.
  - Reduce emergency room use and unnecessary incarceration.
  - 20-bed facility with focus on stabilization with recovery plan.
  - Entry points: Walk-in, law enforcement, first responders, family, friend & community-based referrals.
- 2 STABILIZATION AND TREATMENT CENTER | Wrap-around support services to stabilize & maintain individuals in need**
  - Outpatient treatment directed toward stabilization and recovery.
  - Community-driven services address behavioral health, substance use, suicide and opioid crisis.
  - Designed to change criminal patterns and reduce recidivism.
  - Supports re-entry and reintegration for residents back into the community.
- 3 COURT AND JAIL ALTERNATIVES | An innovative collaboration between the judicial system, law enforcement, behavioral healthcare and community-based services**
  - 40-bed, monitored facility.
  - Short-term housing and day reporting.
  - Case-managed care, treatment and services.
  - Double the impact and reach of SHARE program.
- 4 BANNOCK COUNTY JAIL | Reduce severe overcrowding of Bannock County Jail**
  - Reduce expansion from 260 beds to an estimated 120-160 beds.
  - Take critical steps to ensure that the appropriate population is incarcerated.
  - Eliminate the potential for a federal mandate to add beds, update and improve the jail facilities to meet minimum required standards and reduce risk of liability.
  - Enable contract with Federal Marshall for increased revenue to Bannock County.
